Qualifications	-To qualify for free surgery, must present proof of NYC residency AND proof of public assistance (example: medicaid, SSD, SSI, food stamps, medicare, public housing, etc) -Clinic open to those not receiving public assistance for a cost -Other requirements: must take away all food/water by midnight night before surgery, pet must be healthy, pet must be between ages of 4 months and 5 years, pet must not be excessively overweight, pet must not be less than 4 lbs, pet must not be brachycephalic breed
